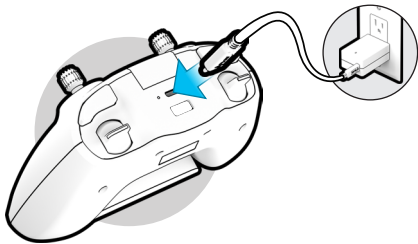

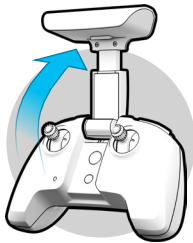

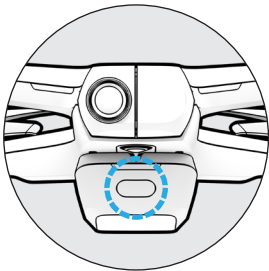


### Charge Controller

Charge Controller using USB-C vehicle charging cable.

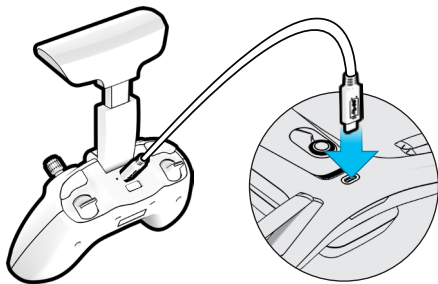


### Unfold Controller to Power On



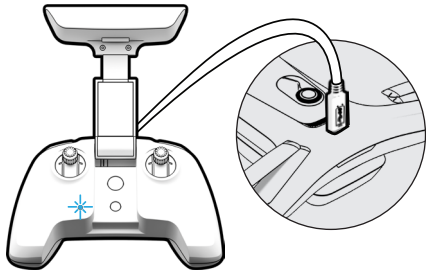
### Power on Skydio 2

Hold the Battery Power Button for 3 seconds to power on Skydio 2.



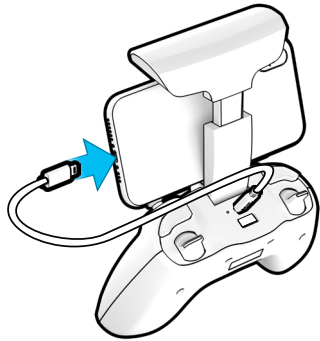
### Plug Controller into Skydio 2

Plug Controller into Skydio 2 using the included USB-C cable.



### Wait Until Light Turns Blue

Wait until light turns solid. Controller is paired with Skydio 2 when the flashing blue light turns solid.



### Connect Phone

Place phone into the antenna arm. Connect phone to controller using the appropriate cable (Android or iOS).
